- Lawyer or other representative
- Other law enforcement agency for training or law enforcement purposes only
- District attorney and Defense attorney for disclosure purposes

HOW DOES THE COURT DECIDE WHETHER OR NOT TO ISSUE A COURT ORDER?

- Is the person requesting authorized to receive disclosure and release?
- Is the release necessary to advance a compelling public interest?
- Is the person requesting seeking to obtain additional evidence in a court case?
- Does the media contain information that is confidential or exempt?
- Will disclosure reveal information that is highly sensitive and personal?
- Will disclosure jeopardise the safety of a person?
- Will disclosure create a serious threat to administration of justice?
- Is confidentiality essential in an ongoing internal or criminal investigation?
