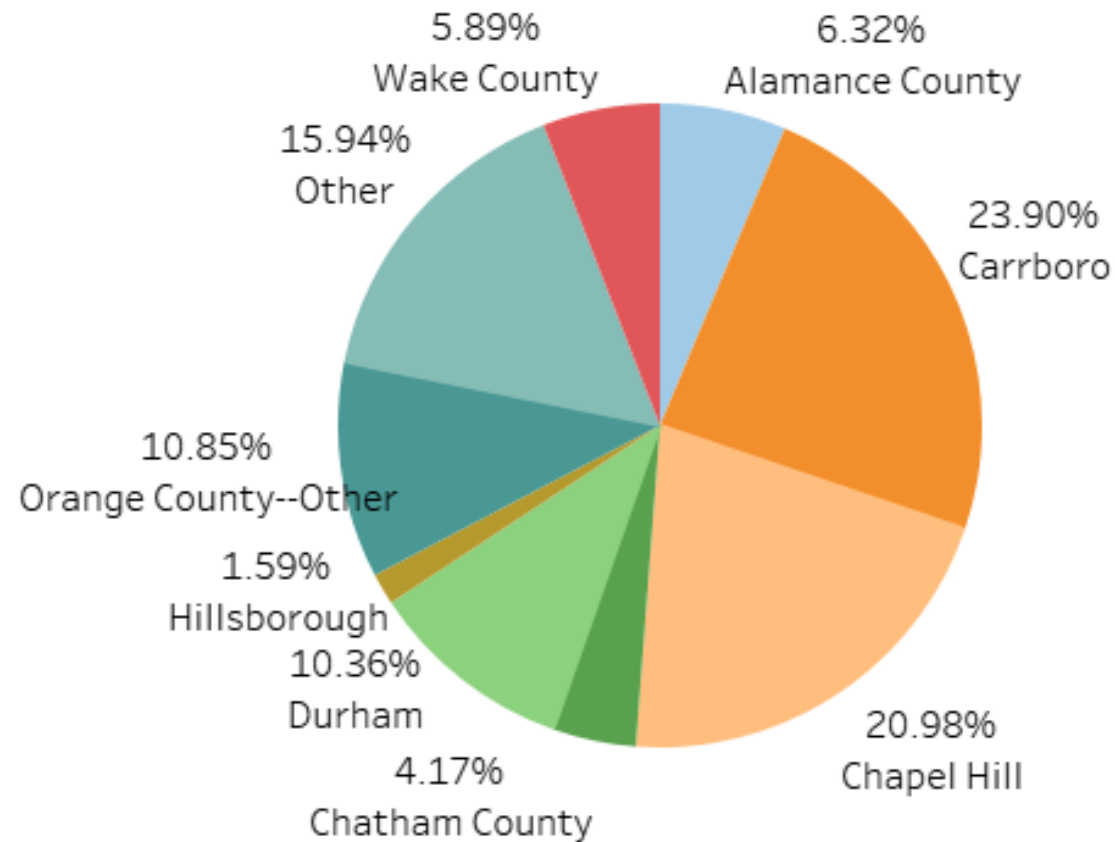

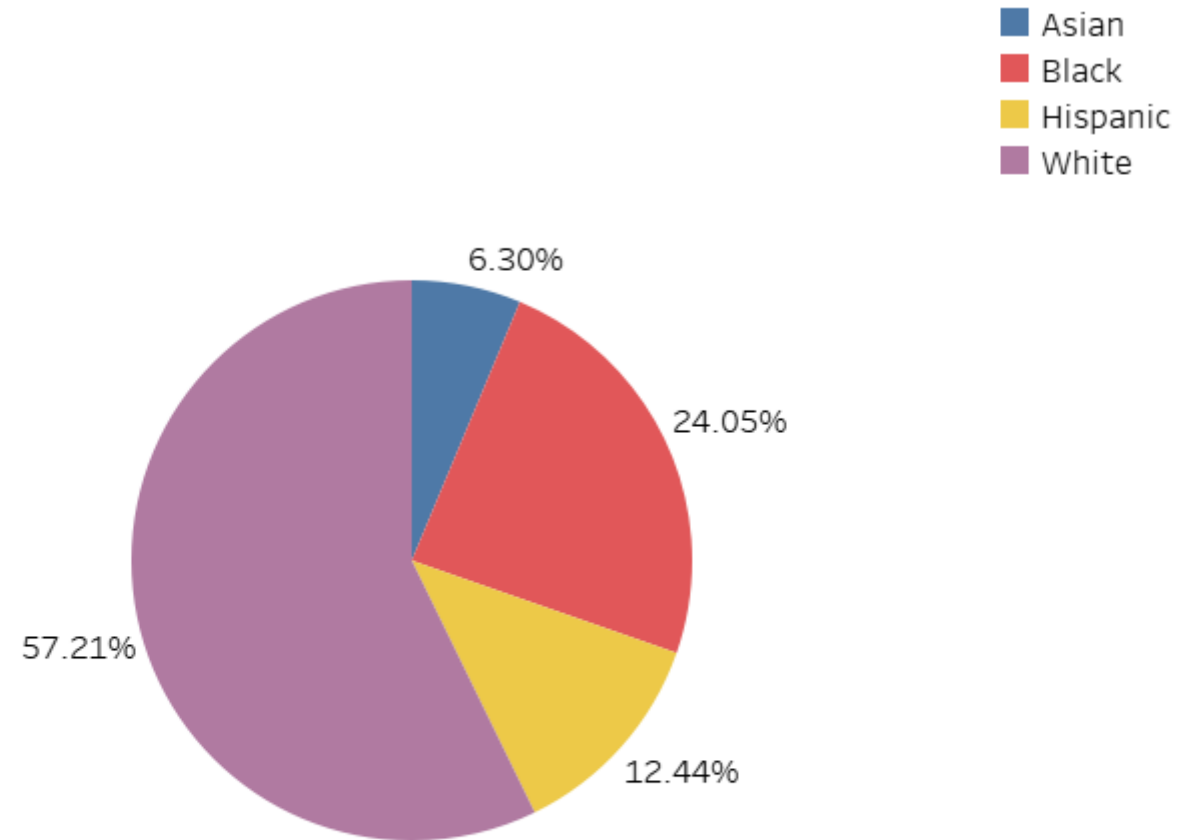
Update on efforts towards bias free policing

Residency Tracking

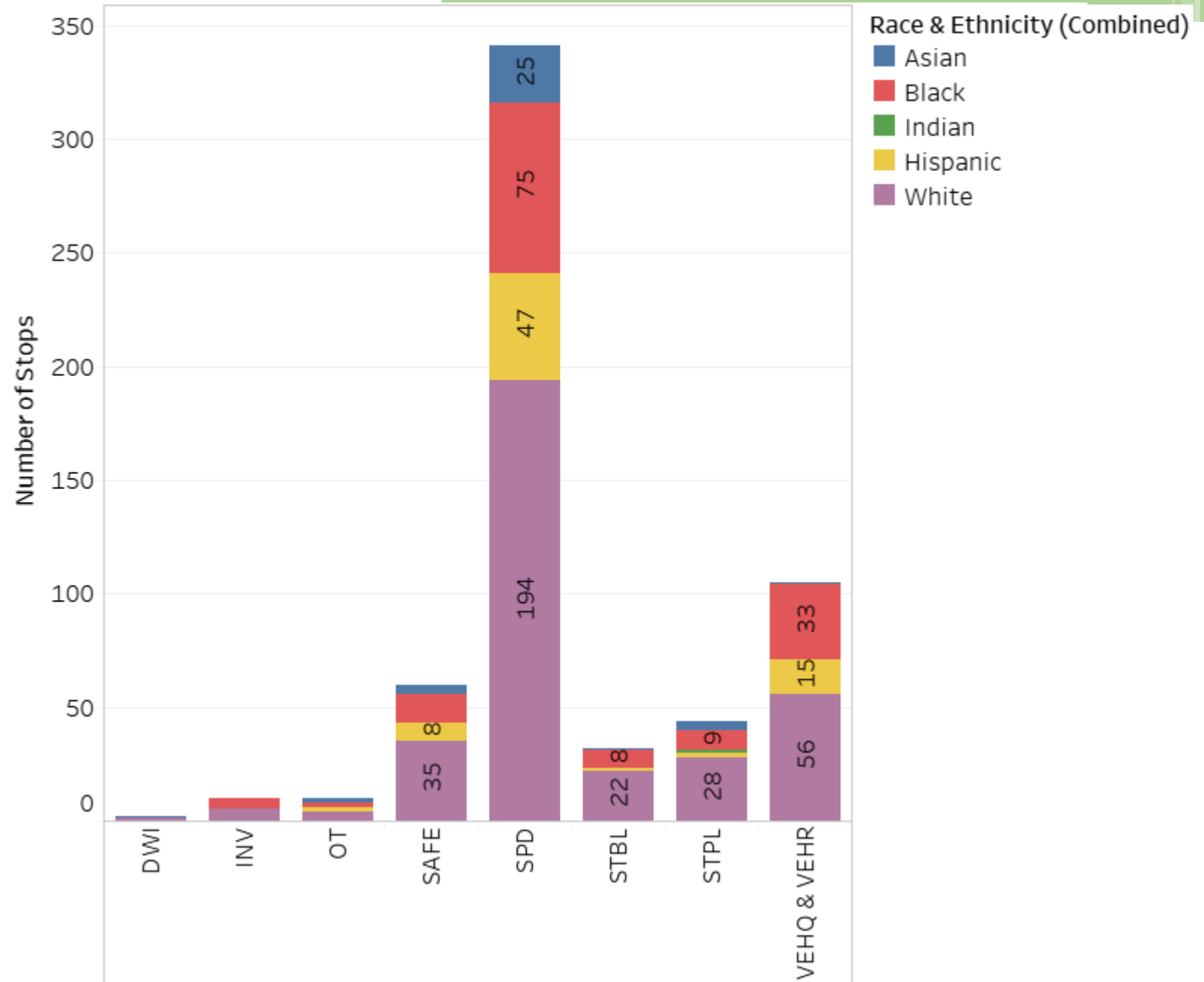
- Residency tracking: Since 2017, we have tracked more specific residency status for traffic stops. This will give us a more accurate idea of the demographics of the population driving through Carrboro, which are thought to be different than the demographics of the population living in Carrboro.

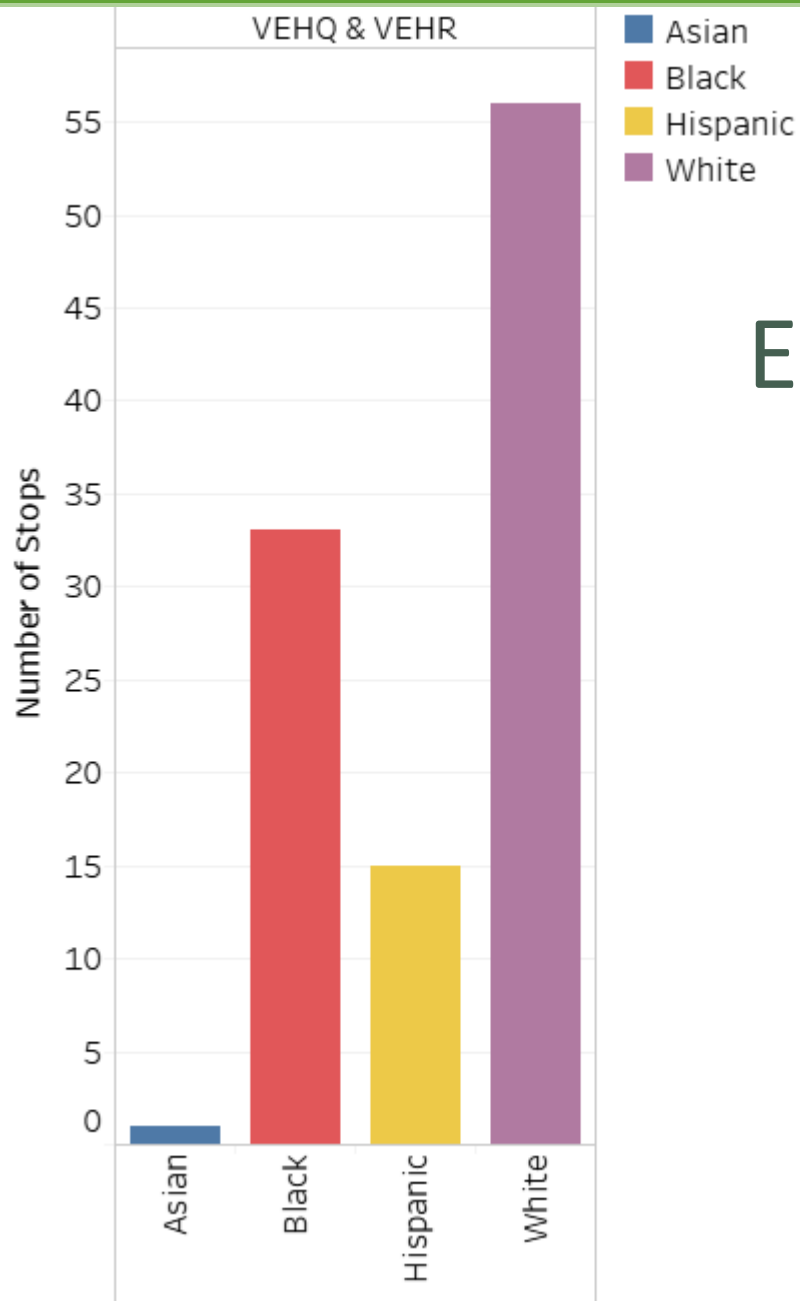


Overall Stop Rate 2019 Q1



Reason for Stop





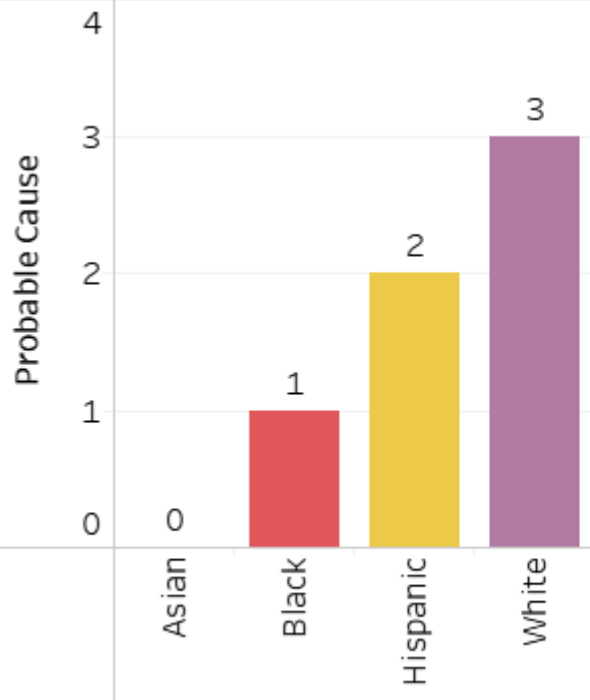
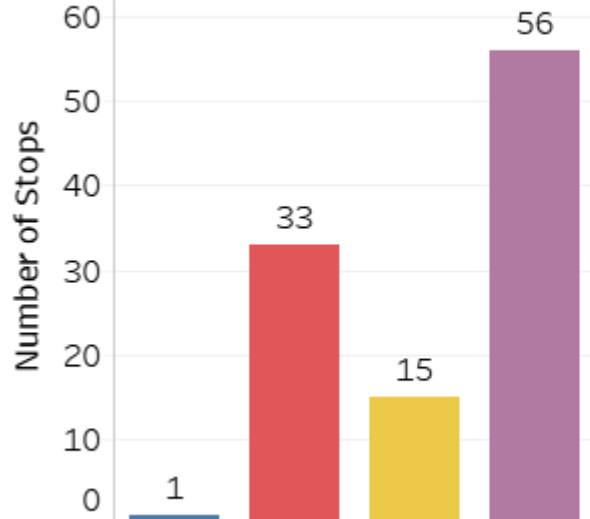

PC Searches and Regulatory Violations

One concern is that equipment and regulatory violations result in more searches, potentially due to racial bias. The number of PC searches is quite low from regulatory stops (less than 10 each quarter), so no conclusion can be drawn.

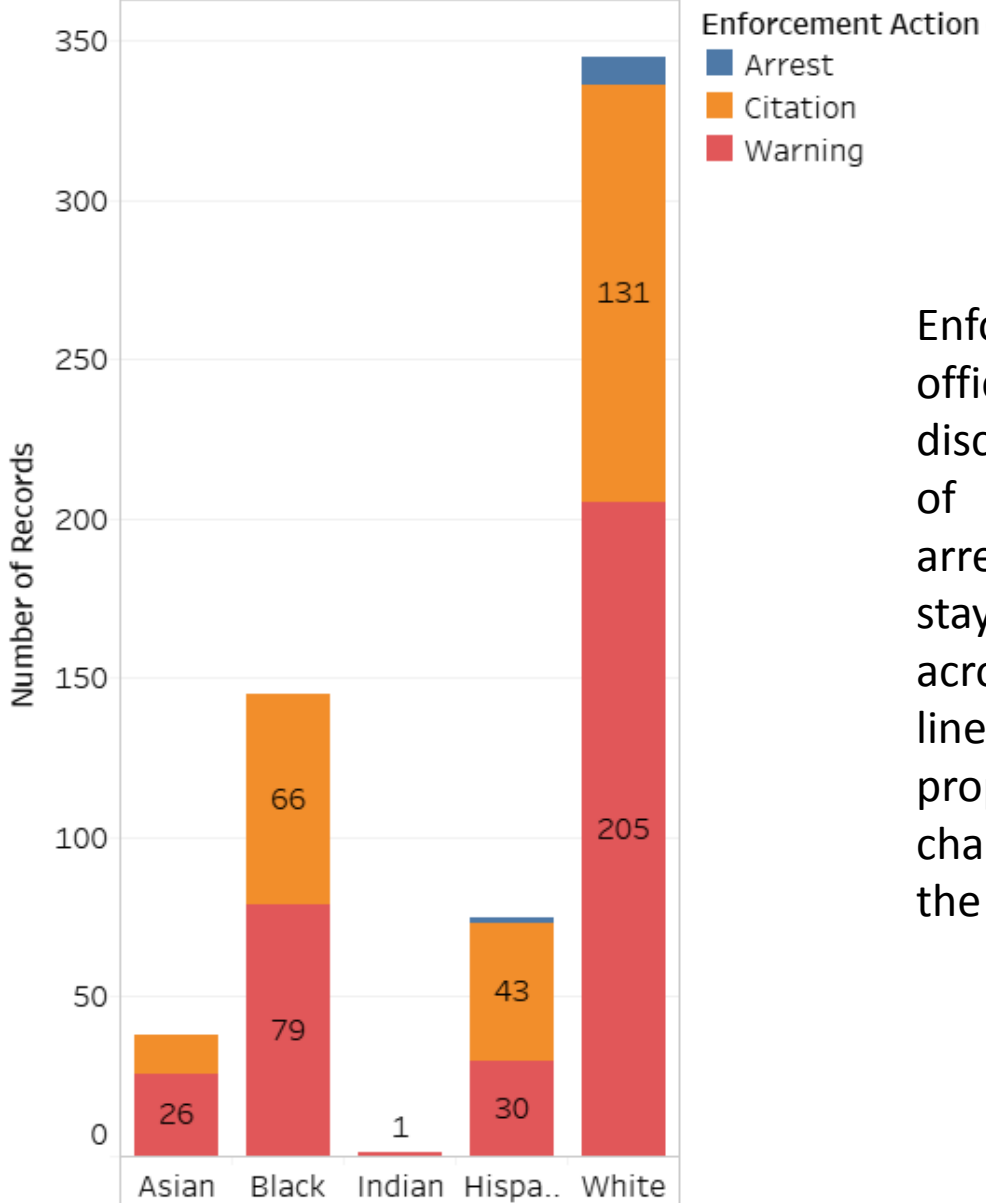

Search Productivity

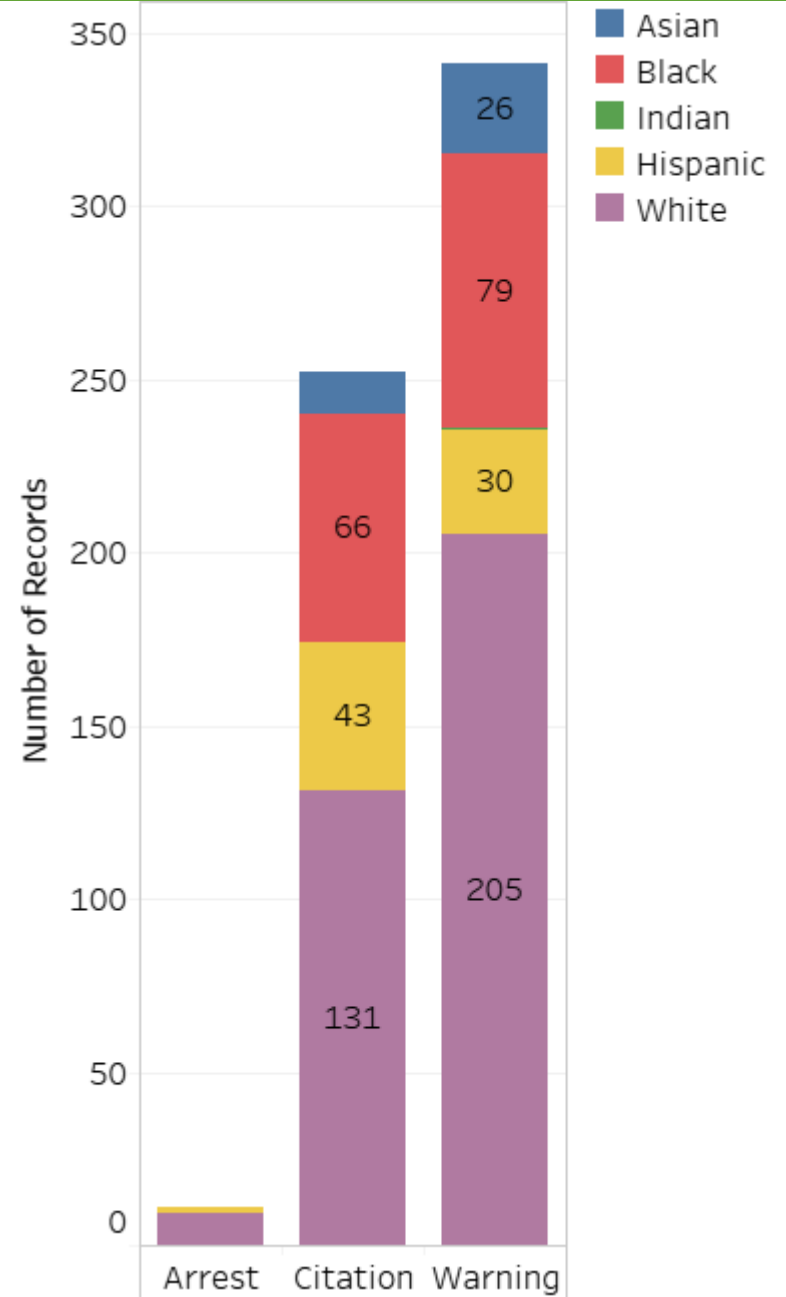
Searches of any type resulting from a traffic stop are relatively uncommon (around 30 per quarter). The chart below shows how often contraband was found and the total number of searches.

Enforcement Action 2019 Q1



Enforcement action where officers show the most discretion. The proportion of arrest/citations/warnings stays mostly consistent across all races and is in line with the overall proportion of stops. These charts present two views of the same data.



Consent Searches

- Zero consent searches for 2019 Q1.

It is worth noting a slight disproportionality in black passengers being searched. However, caution is required when drawing any conclusions due to the low number of PC searches overall.

This chart shows the enforcement taken on stops that included a PC search.

Use of Force

- Four use of force incidents to date in 2019. 1 black male, 2 Hispanic males, 1 white male.
- No conclusions regarding racial patterns can be drawn due to low numbers overall.

Citizen Complaints

- Only 1 citizen complaint in 2019 Q1. It was categorized as “other” and was unfounded.
